



The Oval has been the home ground of Surrey County Cricket Club since it was built in 1845. It was the first ground in England to host international Test cricket, in September 1880.

The final Test match of the English season is traditionally played here.

Historically ground staged the first FA Cup final in 1872 and was the home of the FA Cup final between 1874 and 1892.

The BOX Seat 901 padded was chosen for the recent redevelopment of the members stand.
